**This gathering will be at Naomi Baltuck and Thom Garrard's home in Edmonds—directions below.**

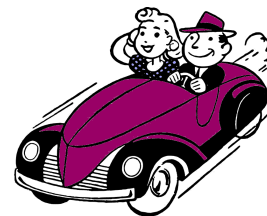
We will be outside and under cover.
